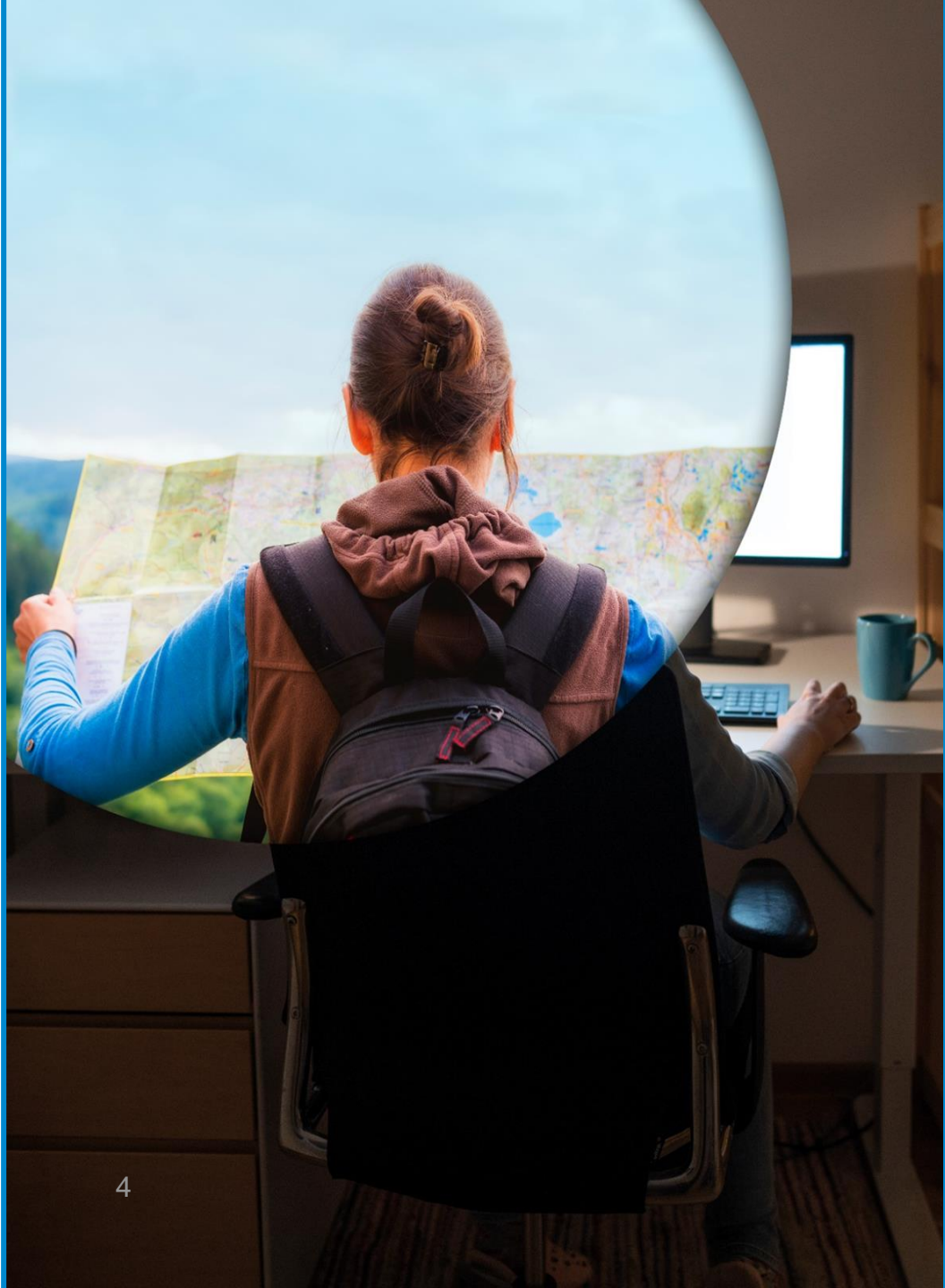

International Credit Mobility

- *Short-term higher education mobility for students, academic and administrative staff*
- *All levels: **Bachelor, Master and PhD** candidates*
- ***Mobility** in any subject or academic discipline*
- *Also supports traineeships for students and training for staff*
- *Study periods and traineeships of **2 – 12** months*

International Credit Mobility (ICM)

EUR 500/participant



Individual support

EUR 700-900/month for students and
EUR 140-180/day for staff

EUR 70/day up to the 14th day of activity and EUR
50/day from 15th to the 30th day of activity in
case of blended mobility



Contribution to travel costs

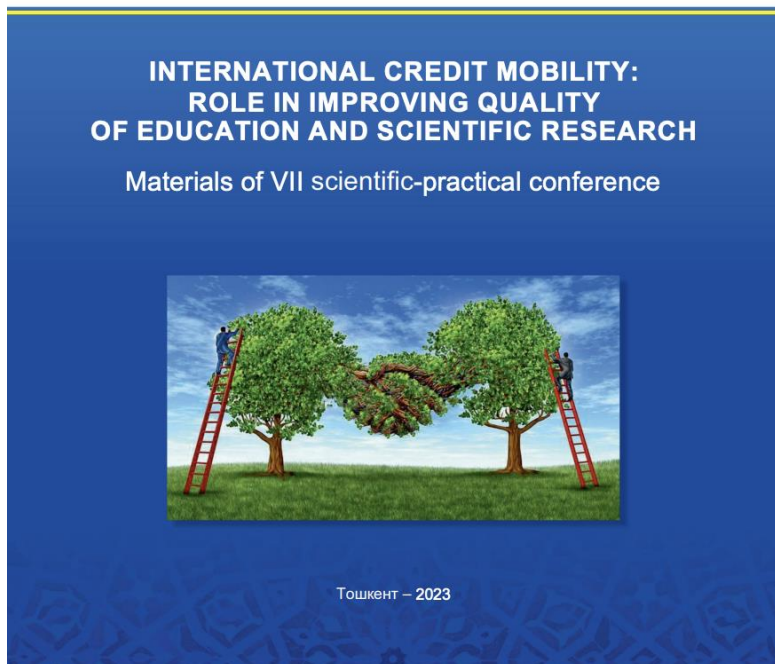
EUR 530-820, depending on distance from

- Duration: min 2 months and max 3 months;
- The scheme will not be open to recent graduates;

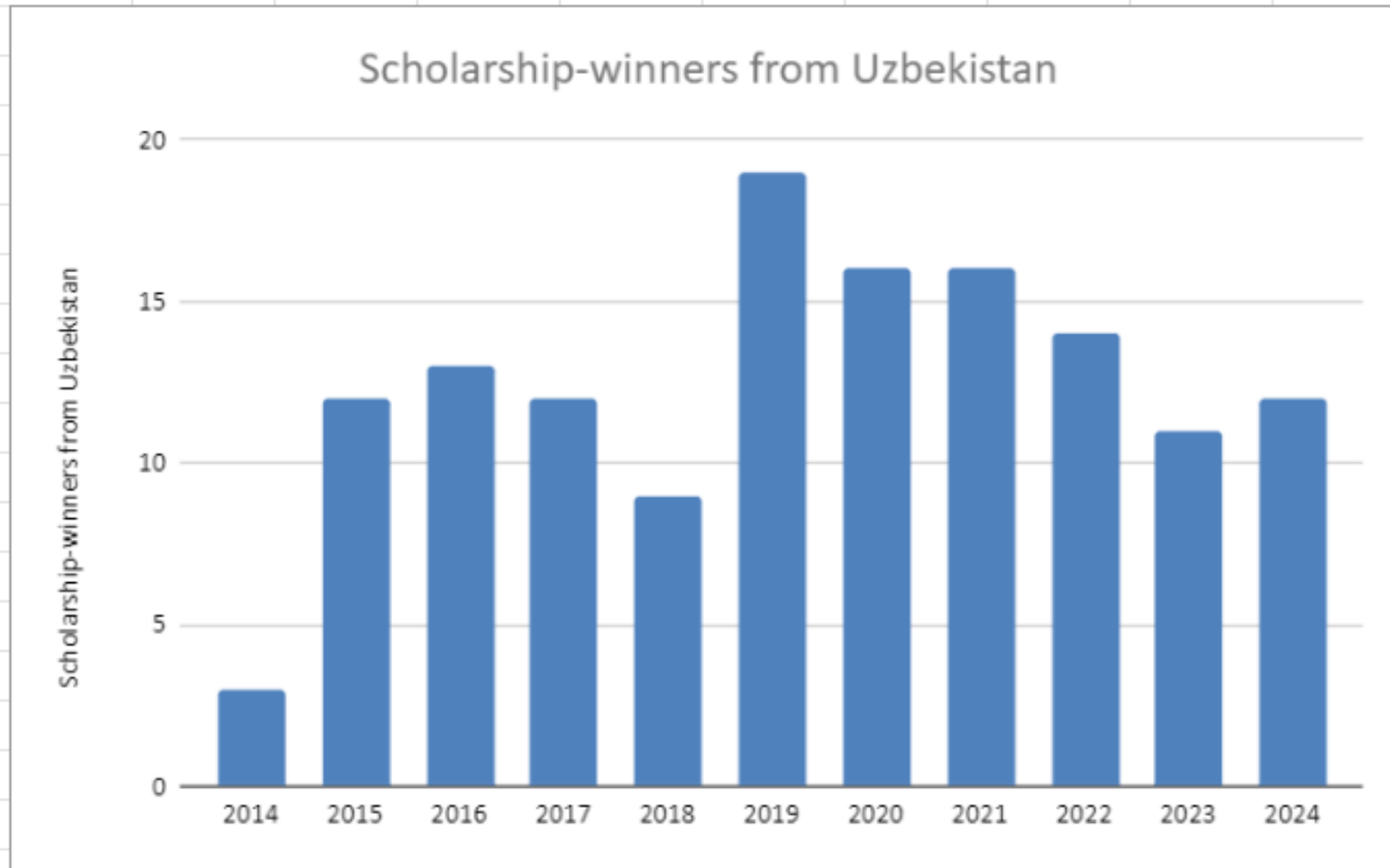
